About

Cura Smiles is a nonprofit organization in San Diego, CA, that provides free dental care to people without health insurance or access to dental care. Many Cura Smiles' patients have not visited a dentist in many years, and others have never received care. Lack of proper oral health leads to chronic pain and infections, and oral health conditions worsen over time. Cura Smiles has a dedicated team of 46 volunteer dentists, dental assistants, hygienists, and students. Through the generosity and support of donors and foundations, Cura Smiles has provided over 6,000 free procedures valued at almost \$1.5 million to date. Cura Smiles is committed to providing sustainable dental care and strives to meet the dental needs of our community.

CURA SMILES PATIENTS

Cura Smiles dental clinic is situated in the vibrant community of City Heights in San Diego CA. Through listening to our patients' stories, we are gaining insights into the underlying factors contributing to their oral health issues. The primary factor is poverty, where oral health takes a back seat to essential needs like rent and groceries. Fear and shame are also significant factors, with some patients visibly trembling during visits or feeling embarrassed and covering their mouths when smiling. Many patients are unaware of the importance of oral hygiene practices like brushing and flossing, nor are they aware of the direct relationship between oral health and overall physical health.

Cura Smiles is committed to overcoming these barriers by welcoming those in need with open arms, providing dental care free of charge and educating our patients about good oral hygiene practices. We strongly believe in providing compassionate care and equipping our patients with the necessary tools and knowledge so they can live healthier, more fulfilling lives.

PATIENT STORY

Sandra came to us from Kathy's House. Her story of transformation is an incredible one! Having battled with drug addiction, Sandra was arrested at the San Diego-Tijuana border with 100 pounds of methamphetamine. After her son posted her bail, the judge released her to Kathy's House, a Christian organization in San Juan Capistrano that helps people rebuild their lives, including helping them experience freedom from addiction. Sandra experienced a radical, grace-filled transformation with God, and was resolved to plead guilty for her drug conviction. Facing up to 100 months in prison, Sandra stood before the judge and said, "Whether you release me today or sentence me to prison, I have everything I need in Jesus. I know I'm going to be okay." Then came the miracle: the judge decided to spare her from prison. He said that something about her case caused him to review it three times, and he was absolutely convinced that her transformation was real. The team from Kathy's House took her home that day to finish her one-year program.

Shortly after that event, Sandra visited Cura Smiles to begin the process of restoring her smile, and she received her dentures in November, 2025. Sandra said, "I never thought this was gonna happen for me. It makes a difference! Without you, I don't know where I'd be with my teeth. It's changed my life already." Sandra is now living in transitional housing, pays rent, has a part-time job, is not afraid to talk with other people, and says that some people don't even recognize her with her new smile! Whole-life transformations, complete with a restored smile, are why we do what we do. Thank you for investing in patients like Sandra.

COLLABORATIONS

Cura Smiles collaborated with 25 organizations this year to provide dental care. Called referring partners, these organizations can offer wrap-around services to our patients which ensures that they receive holistic care. Additionally, Cura Smiles raised more than \$485,000 in support of our mission, and experienced an 85.55% increase in gifts from 2024 to 2025. We also hosted our first fundraiser soiree and netted \$25,000.

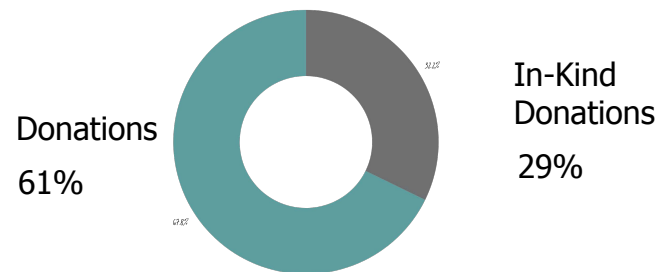

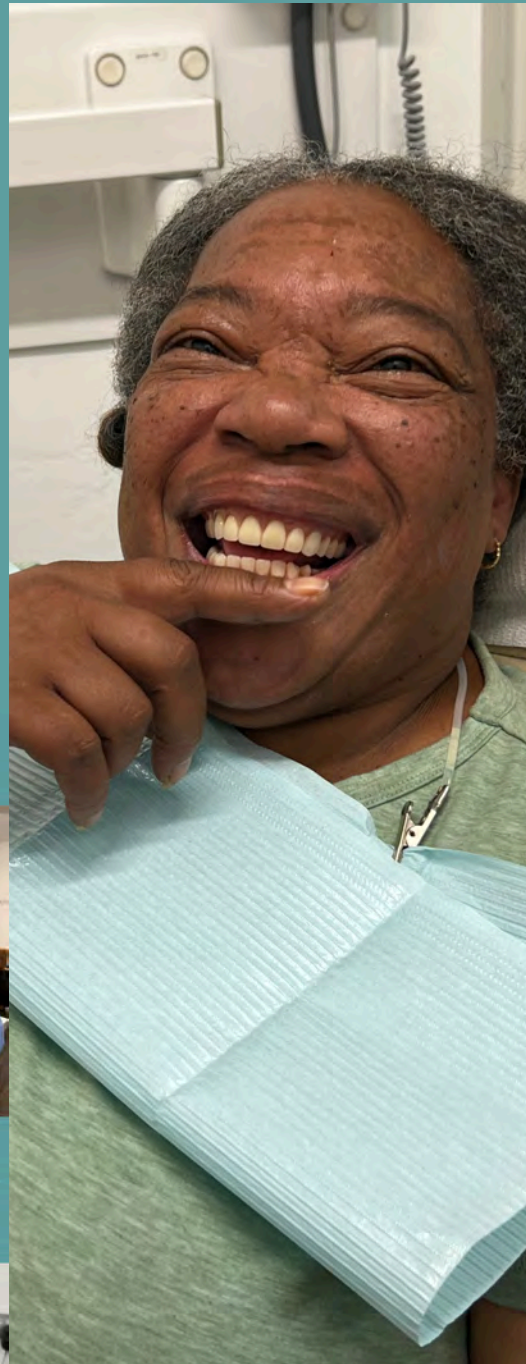
